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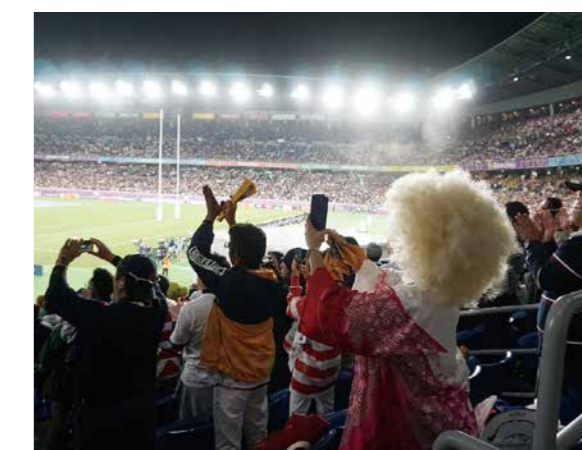

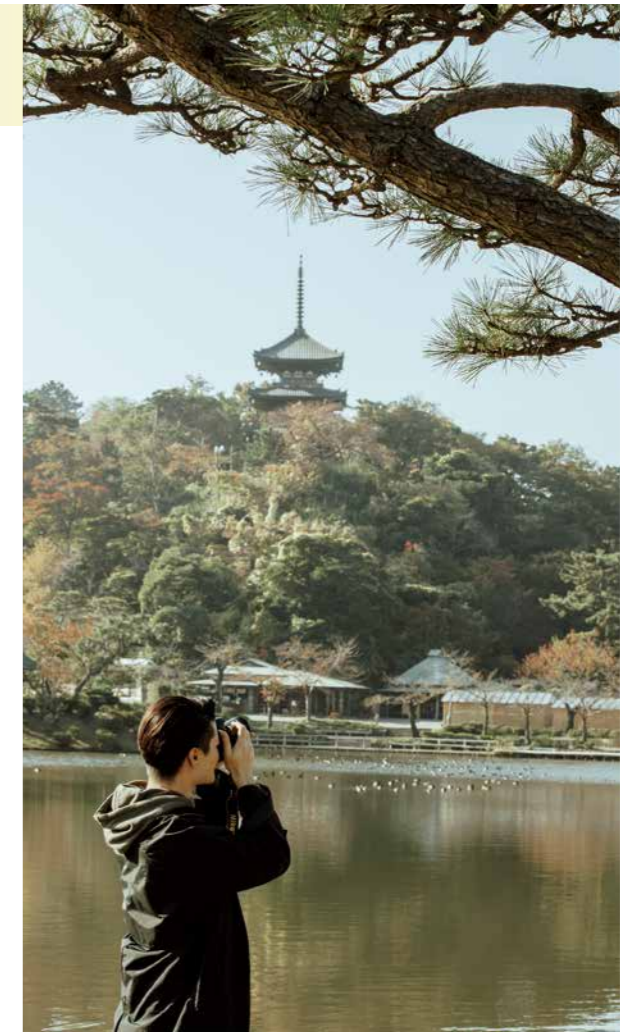

近代横浜のなりたち History of Modern Yokohama

江戸時代の横浜は、100戸足らずの半農半漁の寒村でした。1853年にペリーが浦賀へ来航。1858年に締結された「日米修好通商条約」に基づき開港すると、日本の玄関口、貿易の要として発展していきます。1872年には、新橋と横浜間を走る日本初の鉄道が開通し、1913年には赤レンガ倉庫が竣工。日本各地から集められた生糸が海外へ輸出されていくと共に、海外から物資や人、文化が流れ込み、異国情緒溢れる最先端の街として発展していきました。

1923年の関東大震災、1945年の横浜大空襲では壊滅的な打撃を受け、また終戦後は、市の中心部を連合軍に接収され、復興が思うように進まない時期もありましたが、それらを乗り越え、今日まで発展を続けてきました。関東大震災のがれきを埋め立てた上に作られた日本初の臨海公園である山下公園は、苦難を乗り越えた街のシンボルとして親しまれています。

横浜市民の進取の気風と街への愛着心、歴史あるものを大切にしながら新しい視点を取り入れていく気質は、このような歴史を背景に培われ、今では日本最大の基礎自治体へと成長を遂げたこの街を造る原動力となりました。

During the Edo period, Yokohama was a small farming and fishing village with less than 100 households. In 1853, Commodore Perry and his black ships landed in Uraga. Since the opening of the Port of Yokohama, based on the Treaty of Amity and Commerce between the United States and Japan in 1858, the city has developed as a gateway to Japan and a trading hub. In 1872, Japan's first railway was opened between Shimbashi and Yokohama. In 1913, the Red Brick Warehouse was completed. As raw silk gathered from all over Japan was exported from the city's port, a variety of goods, people, and cultures were brought to Yokohama, which contributed to its development as a multicultural and advanced city.

Yokohama experienced devastating damage from the Great Kanto Earthquake in 1923 and the Bombing of Yokohama in 1945. In the difficult times after the war, the central urban area was requisitioned by the Allied Forces, which further delayed its restoration. In spite of these struggles, the city was able to overcome its hardships and continue to grow. The first seaside park in Japan, Yamashita Park was built using rubble from the Great Kanto Earthquake. The park is loved by locals as a symbol of a city that has overcome many hardships. This historical backdrop has fostered the citizens' progressive spirit, commitment to the city, acceptance of new perspectives, and appreciation for historical things, all of which act as the driving force that contributes to Yokohama's development as the largest municipality in Japan.

The city center was formed on reclaimed land at the time of the port opening. Due to the comparatively recent development of the urban district, it is characterized by its grid of streets and avenues.

In 1911, Red Brick Warehouse No.2 equipped with a crane, then known as the Yokohama Customs Shinko Pier Warehouse, was completed. The state-of-the-art Red Brick Warehouse No.1 equipped with elevators was completed in 1913.

Many buildings were destroyed by the Great Kanto Earthquake, and almost 90% of the urban districts in Yokohama were lost. Built with rubble from the earthquake, Yamashita Park is the first seaside park in Japan.

The total number of inbound and outbound passengers per day using Yokohama Station's 9 railroad lines is the 4th largest in the world.



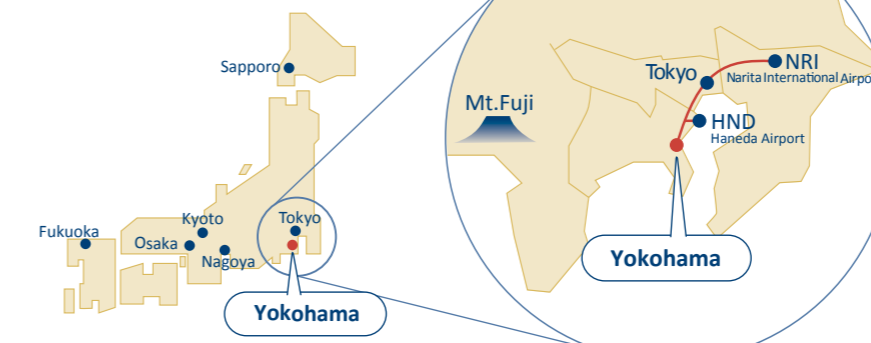
